

# Fire Ban in Effect



Please be advised that the Township of Douro-Dummer has declared a fire ban effective immediately due to very dry conditions which pose an extreme fire hazard.

Day visitors are not permitted to use charcoal or wood fires/BBQs. The safe use of propane BBQs is permitted.

The municipality's bylaw allows for recreational fires within the campground only.

The following conditions apply:

- ✘ fires are not permitted between 10am and 7pm
- ✘ campfires must be in a pit and cannot be more than one meter in diameter
- ✘ the fire cannot be close to or in the forest
- ✘ only clean dry firewood may be used; no painted/pressure treated/glued wood or prohibited materials
- ✘ no fireworks, including sparklers
- ✘ no candles, patio torches, burning insect repellents
- ✘ no smoking on trails
- ✘ do not leave a fire unattended
- ✓ be sure to extinguish your fire
- ✓ contact staff if you need assistance

All visitors must comply with the ban. Failure to do so may result in eviction. Updated information will be posted as it becomes available. Thank you for your co-operation.
